

Sign up for Leadership University Park 2017-18

A collaborative program involving the City and the University Park Community League, Leadership University Park seeks to familiarize residents with the community's challenges, opportunities and resources. With the ultimate objective of encouraging class participants to serve in community leadership positions, the program is centered around 60-minute seminars that touch on every major aspect of City operations.

PROGRAM DETAILS AND FORMAT:

The 2017-2018 Leadership UP program will involve monthly presentations over a two-year period. Overall, there will be 17 class periods and a graduation luncheon.

The 2017-2018 program will begin Thursday, January 12. All class sessions will be 60 minutes. Classes will be held on Thursdays at City Hall, unless otherwise noted. Classes will not be conducted in December, June, July or August.

Along with providing class participants with a thorough understanding of all aspects of City operations, there will also be separate presentations from Southern Methodist University, the Highland Park Independent School District, the Park Cities YMCA and the George W. Bush Presidential Library.

Program highlights include: a class on the history of the City presented by those who know it best, the Mayors who have served the community over the last 30 years; an overview of the City's Capital Improvement Projects; an overview of the City's annual Budget process; a review of the City's financial standing; a tour of the City's public library; a tour of the City's Peek Service Center, which is home to the City's Public Works, Parks and Recreation and Equipment Services operations; and a family night dinner with the Fire Department.

Class Size - Open to all University Park residents, the program is limited to the first 25 participants who apply.

Tuition - \$250 a person.
